AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Officers of Franklin County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 5th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, which relates to salaries of county officers of Franklin County, as amended by section I of chapter 397 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended to read as follows:

Franklin County: County Commissioners, \$900 \$1,000; clerk of courts, \$3,700 \$4,100; county attorney, \$5,000; county treasurer, \$1,200 \$1,300; sheriff, \$4,000 \$4,400; register of deeds, \$4,100 \$4,500; judge of probate, \$2,000 \$2,200; register of probate, \$3,600 \$4,000.
