AN ACT Relating to Packaging of Election Ballots.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 21, § 926, sub-§ 1, amended. The first sentence of subsection 1 of section 926 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

The election clerks shall pack each lot of both used and unused ballots and the tabulation of the count in that lot in a sealed package.
