AN ACT Relating to Unused Ballots Left in Voting Booths.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 21, § 603, sub-§ 3, additional. Section 603 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection 3 to read as follows:

3. Inspected. Ballot clerks shall inspect voting booths from time to time during voting hours, removing any unused ballots from the booths, and such ballots shall be kept separately and not given to voters.
