AN ACT Relating to Annual Estimates for County Taxes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 30, § 252, amended. The last 2 sentences of the 2nd paragraph of section 252 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes are amended to read as follows:

Whenever any specific appropriation of a department or agency of the county government shall prove insufficient to pay the expenditures required for the statutory purposes for which such appropriation was made, the county commissioners, at the request of such department or agency, may transfer from any other specific appropriation of such department or agency such amount as may be deemed necessary to meet such expenditure, **provided that the amount so transferred shall not exceed, in any one calendar year or fiscal year, 5% of the total tax commitment for the year in which the transfer is made.** ~~This paragraph shall apply to Androscoggin County and York County only.~~

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 30, § 252, amended. Section 252 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph, to read as follows:

The Department of Audit shall check periodically any such transfers as shall be made by the county commissioners in the several counties as authorized in this section.
