IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Appropriating Moneys for Improvements at Pleasant Point and Indian Township Reservations.

Improvements at Indian reservations; appropriation. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$5,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968 and the sum of \$5,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969 to the Department of Indian Affairs to provide for construction of recreational and playground facilities at the Pleasant Point and Indian Township Passamaquoddy Indian reservations in Washington County.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

No such facilities presently exist. The size and youthfulness of these 2 communities' populations and their distance from suitable recreational facilities justify this expenditure, which would materially contribute to the communities' health and well-being.
