STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Election of Constables in City of Westbrook.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1907, c. 257, § 4, amended. The 2nd and 3rd sentences of the first paragraph of section 4 of chapter 257 of the private and special laws of 1907, as repealed and replaced by section 2 of chapter 36 of the private and special laws of 1955, are amended to read as follows:

Two aldermen, a warden and a ward clerk and a constable shall be elected in each ward, being residents in the ward where elected. The city council may divide any ward into 2 or more precincts, and in which event additional wardens and ward clerks and constables shall be elected by each precinct from residents therein.
