SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 435, L. D. 1154, Bill, "An Act  
Relating to Protecting Source of Public Water Supply."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 1 and  
inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 1. R. S., T. 22, §2436, amended. The first paragraph  
of section 2436 of Title 22 of the Revised Statutes is repealed  
and the following enacted in place thereof:

Any water utility or municipality supplying water to the  
public is authorized to take reasonable methods to protect its  
source of public water supply from pollution. It may enter upon  
land within 1,000 feet of the high water mark of any lake or  
pond used as a source of public water supply, a well used as a  
source of public water supply, a spring used as a source of public  
water supply, the intake structure in a river, brook or stream used  
as a public water supply, and upon land used for commercial or  
industrial purposes having a system of drainage or sewage flowing  
or seeping into a source of public water supply, and inspect the  
system of drainage and sewage of any building or structure thereon.  
Any local or state health inspector or officer may order the owner  
of any building or structure thereon having a system of drainage  
or sewage flowing or seeping into and contaminating said source  
of public water supply to remedy the situation. Such order shall  
be in writing and state a time within which the order must be  
complied with.'
