# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

#### AN ACT Relating to Education of Indians.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 1452, amended. Section 1452 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 450 of the public laws of 1965, is amended by adding a new paragraph to read as follows:

Any member of the Penobscot or Passamaquoddy Tribes of Indians, not residing on a reservation, of any age may attend any high school as a regular student, take vocational training, evening or adult education courses. Tuition shall be paid by the State at the rate of the legal tuition charge for the high school attended.
