STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Refunding of Unexpended Portion of the Sardine Tax Funds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 36, § 4699, sub-§ 2, amended. Subsection 2 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
- 2. Balance of funds. Any unnecessary unexpended balance of funds collected by the sardine tax shall be returned to the packers in proportion to the amount they paid in. The balance in such amounts as shall be from time to time determined by the Maine Sardine Council:
