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**AN ACT Relating to Refunding of Unexpended Portion of the Sardine Tax Funds.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 36, § 4699, sub-§ 2, amended.** Subsection 2 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

**2. Balance of funds. Any unnecessary unexpended balance of funds collected by the sardine tax shall be returned to the packers in proportion to the amount they paid in.** The balance in such amounts as shall be from time to time determined by the Maine Sardine Council:
