AN ACT Relating to State Appropriations for Regional Planning Commissions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 30, § 4502, sub-§ 4, additional. Section 4502 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection 4 to read as follows:

4. State aid. The State shall appropriate and pay to a regional planning commission established under this section an amount equal to the total local contributions toward the annual cost of operating such commission. The Division of Planning and Research in the Department of Economic Development shall develop a state plan for the creation of regional planning areas throughout the State for the purpose of approving applications for grants under this section.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund a sum of \$200,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969 to carry out the purposes of this Act.
