**RESOLVE in Favor of Loudon C. Minor of Cape Elizabeth for Automobile
Damage by Escapee from Boys Training Center.**

Loudon C. Minor; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$250 to be paid to Loudon C. Minor of Cape Elizabeth as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for damage to his car by an escapee from the Boys Training Center.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Minor's car was parked at curb-side on Pleasant Avenue near the Baptist Church at Deering Center. On August 12, 1966 an escapee from the Boys Training Center stole a car from in front of 25 Smith Street, Portland, and in a wild, high speed chase crashed into Mr. Minor's car causing a great deal of damage.
