STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, to Reconstruct Mallison Falls Bridge Between the Towns of Windham and Gorham.

Mallison Falls Bridge; reconstructed. Resolve: That the State Highway commissioner is directed to reconstruct Mallison Falls Bridge between the Town of Windham and Gorham, Cumberland County; and be it further

Resolved: That there is allocated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$150,000 to carry out the purposes of this resolve.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mallison Bridge is badly in need of reconstruction to prevent possible injuries to the traveling public.
