IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to Political Composition of the Various Boards and Commissions of City of Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. XVI, § 2, repealed and replaced. Section 2 of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939, as amended, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

Sec. 2. Enrollment of members in political parties. Three appointive members of the board of finance and no more, and 3 non-aldermanic members of each other departmental board of commission and no more, shall be enrolled in that political party which, at the time of their appointment, had polled the plurality of votes in this city for the office of Governor in the last gubernatorial election preceding the date of appointment. The term "enrollment" as used herein shall mean enrollment in the party represented for at least 180 days prior to the date of appointment and no enrollment in any other party within one year of said date.

Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall become effective on January 1, 1968.
