AN ACT Relating to Lights on Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 1366, amended. The next to the last paragraph of section 1366 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

All lights, reflectors and signal lamps required by law to be displayed on the rear of all motor vehicles, trailers and semitrailers of 7 feet or over in width shall be at least within 12 inches of the extreme extension of the rear of such vehicle, except that on flat-body dump trucks of 7 feet or over in width such lights and signal lamps may be displayed on the rear of the frame of the vehicle **but no load carried on such vehicle shall be allowed to obscure such lights.**
