AN ACT Authorizing Permanent Registration Plates for Fleet Operated Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 246-A, additional. Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 246-A, to read as follows:

§ 246-A. Fleet operated vehicles

Any person, partnership or corporation, owning, leasing or operating a fleet of 10 or more truck tractors, trailers, semitrailers or any combination thereof may make application upon a blank supplied by the Secretary of State for a permanent registration plate to be displayed on the rear of each trailer or semitrailer so owned, leased or operated. The Secretary of State shall furnish the person, partnership or corporation with one permanent registration plate for each trailer or semitrailer in the fleet, which shall expire 6 years from date of issue and payment of the registration fee shall be on issuance of the plates in full for the 6-year period as of March 1st of that year.
