**AN ACT Permitting Sheriffs to Issue Permits to Motor Vehicle Owners for
Operation to Motor Vehicle Inspection Stations.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 2122, amended. The 5th paragraph from the end of section 2122 of Title 29 is amended to read as follows:

The Chief of the State Police, **the sheriff of each county or his deputy**, a state police officer or a state driver license examiner may issue a permit to owners of motor vehicles which are not inspected to enable them to operate such vehicle to an inspection station for the purpose of complying with this law.
