SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 476, L. D. 1197, Bill, "An Act Relating to Certification of Qualifications of Candidates for Municipal Office in City of Lewiston."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 6. Certification of qualifications. Before the city clerk proceeds to have ballots printed according to section 5 of this article, he shall examine the qualifications of all candidates for municipal offices and ascertain that each such candidate fulfills all requirements of this charter as regards to qualifications for holding public office in this city.'
