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### **AN ACT Relating to Certification of Qualifications of Candidates for Municipal Office in City of Lewiston.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. III, § 6, additional.** Article III of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939 is amended by adding a new section 6, to read as follows:

**Sec. 6. Certification of qualifications.** Before the city clerk proceeds to have ballots printed according to section 5 of this article, it shall be the duty of the chairman of the registration board of voters to examine the qualifications of all candidates for municipal offices and to ascertain that each such candidate fulfills all requirements of this charter as regards to qualifications for holding public office in this city. When the chairman of the registration board of voters has determined that all qualification requirements are met by a candidate, he shall so inform in writing the city clerk who will then proceed to place the candidate's name on the ballot for the election.
