AN ACT Permitting Pin Ball Machines on Premises of Liquor Licensees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 10, additional. Title 28 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new section 10, to read as follows:

§ 10. Pin ball machines permitted

Liquor licensees may have or permit pin ball machines on his licensed premises.
