AN ACT to Provide for a Graduated License Fee for Retail Sale of Malt Liquor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 701, amended. The last 3 lines of the 2nd paragraph of section 701 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes, as last repealed and replaced by section 54 of chapter 513 of the public laws of 1965, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

Retail store—Malt liquor only

Amount of malt liquor purchased in 12 months	Fee
Any amount to \$6,000	\$ 75.00
\$ 6,001 to \$ 9,000	100.00
\$ 9,001 to \$12,000	125.00
\$12,001 to \$15,000	150.00
\$15,001 to \$18,000	175.00
\$18,001 to \$21,000	200.00
Any amount above \$21,001	210.00
