STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Increasing Salary of Administrative Hearing Commissioner.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., T. 5, § 2401, sub-§ 3, amended. Subsection 3 of section 2401 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
- 3. Compensation of Hearing Commissioner. The Hearing Commissioner shall receive an annual compensation of \$\$,000 \$12,500 and shall be entitled to actual and necessary expenses in the performance of his duties. He may employ necessary clerical assistance.
- Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Administrative Hearing Commissioner the sum of \$3,380 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968 and the sum of \$4,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969 for the purposes of carrying out this Act.
