AN ACT Increasing Salary of Administrative Hearing Commissioner.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 5, § 2401, sub-§ 3, amended. Subsection 3 of section 2401 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

3. Compensation of Hearing Commissioner. The Hearing Commissioner shall receive an annual compensation of ~~\$8,000~~ **\$12,500** and shall be entitled to actual and necessary expenses in the performance of his duties. He may employ necessary clerical assistance.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Administrative Hearing Commissioner the sum of \$3,380 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968 and the sum of \$4,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969 for the purposes of carrying out this Act.
