AN ACT Increasing Fish and Game License Fees for Forestry District Fund.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 1607, amended. Section 1607 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph, to read as follows:

All hunting and fishing license fees under Title 12, Part 3, shall each be increased 25c and notwithstanding any other provision of law, such increase in fees shall be credited to the Maine Forestry District Fund and used for the purposes specified in this section.
