AN ACT Increasing Salary of the Adjutant General.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 25, § 712, amended. The 9th paragraph of section 712 of Title 25 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 416 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended to read as follows:

The Adjutant General shall receive an annual salary of ~~\$12,500~~ \$15,500. He shall receive no other fee, emolument or perquisite.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Adjutant General the sum of \$2,250 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968 and the sum of \$3,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969 to carry out the purposes of this Act.
