AN ACT Relating to Salaries of Director of Legislative Research and Legislative Finance Officer.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 3, § 163, sub-§ 7, amended. The last sentence of subsection 7 of section 163 of Title 3 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 4 of chapter 412 of the public laws of 1965, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

The Legislative Research Committee shall fix his salary and he shall receive any necessary traveling expenses;

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 3, § 163, sub-§ 15, amended. The 4th sentence of subsection 15 of section 163 of Title 3 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 2 of chapter 341 of the public laws of 1965, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

The Legislative Research Committee shall fix his salary and he shall receive any necessary traveling expenses, which salary and expenses shall be paid from the legislative appropriation.
