# AN ACT Relating to Issuance of Motor Vehicle Registrations by Municipal Tax Officers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 29, § 52, amended. Section 52 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

#### § 52. Deputy

The Secretary of State may appoint and deputize agents, examiners and inspectors, stationed at convenient places in the State, to receive applications for registration and licenses for the operation of motor vehicles and to conduct examinations when ordered by the Secretary of State.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 29, § 117, additional. Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 117, to read as follows:

## § 117. Registration in municipalities

The collector of taxes of each municipality or such other person as a municipality may designate to collect the excise taxes on motor vehicles as provided in Title 36, section 1487, is declared to be an agent of the Secretary of State to receive applications for registration and to issue such registrations, and to collect the fees required therefor. Such agents shall transmit as required by the Secretary of State such records as the Secretary of State may require of all registrations issued and shall account to the Secretary of State for all fees collected under this section.
