STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Penalty for Exceeding Appropriation for Economic and Recreational Development in Oxford County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 10, § 911, amended. Section 911 of Title 10 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 122 of the public laws of 1965, is amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

Any county commissioner of Oxford County who exceeds the appropriation authorized by this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$300 or by imprisonment for not more than 30 days, or by both.
