STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Failure to Send County Estimates to Municipalities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 253, amended. Section 253 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 162 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

Any county commissioner who fails to transmit the county estimates to each municipality in his county as provided in this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$300 or by imprisonment for not more than 30 days, or by both.
