HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 822, L.D. 1230, Bill, "An Act  
Providing Funds for Relocating of Maine Central Railroad  
Tracks in Livermore Falls."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the  
enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Appropriation. There is appropriated to the Town of  
Livermore Falls from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General  
Fund the sum of \$15,000 to help defray the cost of relocating  
the Maine Central Railroad tracks in order to eliminate 2 grade  
crossings on Main and Depot Streets in said Livermore Falls.  
Such appropriation shall be a continuing carrying account until  
June 30, 1969. This appropriation is contingent upon the Town  
of Livermore Falls paying a comparable amount of \$15,000 and  
the availability of federal funds for the completion of this  
project. The federal funds thus furnished shall not affect the  
amount of federal funds that are presently allocated or will be  
allocated to the State of Maine for highway construction.'
