RESOLVE to Provide Funds for the Purchase of Copies of the "History of the Town of Lisbon."

Purchase copies of "History of the Town of Lisbon." Resolved: That the State purchase 200 copies of the book entitled "History of the Town of Lisbon" by Francis W. Plummer, Sr., at \$5 per copy, said books to be exchanged or distributed at the discretion of the State Librarian; and be it further

Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$1,000 for the purpose of this resolve.

It has been the practice of the Legislature to encourage historic books, which help to preserve the history of our State, by purchasing enough copies for distribution to our young people of Maine.
