HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 832, L.D. 1240, Bill, "An Act
Granting Knox Agricultural Society Right to Construct
Grandstand Across St. George River."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the enacting clause,
the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do
not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted
as emergencies; and

Whereas, the Knox Agricultural Society Fair will be held
in August 1967; and

Whereas, the following legislation is vitally necessary to
begin the construction of the grandstand as soon as possible in
order for it to be completed in time for the 1967 Fair; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
Maine, and require the following legislation as immediately
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
safety; now, therefore,'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof the
following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the
preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'
