AN ACT Increasing Penalties for Violation of Fishing Regulations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2560, amended. Section 2560 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended to read as follows:

§ 2560. Penalties

Whoever violates any provision of sections 2552 and 2553 shall pay a fine of not less than \$20 nor more than \$30, and costs of prosecution, for each offense; and in addition thereto, \$7 \$10 for each fish taken, caught, killed or had in possession in violation of any provision of said sections.
