## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Municipal Regulation of Rates for Cable Television Services.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 30, § 2151, sub-§ 2, ¶ H, additional. Paragraph H of subsection 2 of section 2151 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end a new sentence to read as follows:

The municipal officers shall establish rates or charges for cable television services.

- Sec. 2. R. S., T. 20, § 2151, sub-§ 2, ¶ I, additional. Subsection 2 of section 2151 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new paragraph I, to read as follows:
  - I. The maximum rental charge for the use of electric light or telephone poles leased to cable television companies shall not exceed \$1 per pole per annum.
