**AN ACT Changing the Name of the Department of Economic Development to
the Department of Commerce and Industry.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 10, § 401, amended. The first sentence of section 401 of Title 10 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

‘The Department of ~~Economic Development~~ **Commerce and Industry**, as heretofore established and hereinafter in this chapter called the “department” shall be under the supervision and control of a Commissioner of ~~Economic Development~~ **Commerce and Industry**, hereinafter in this chapter called the “commissioner.”

Sec. 2. Application. Wherever in the Revised Statutes and public laws the term “Department of Economic Development” appears it shall mean the ‘Department of Commerce and Industry’ and wherever the term “Commissioner of Economic Development” appears it shall mean ‘Commissioner of Commerce and Industry.’
