STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Creating an Informational Center on the Capitol Grounds in Augusta.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., T. 10, § 551, sub-§ 5, additional. Section 551 of Title 10 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection 5, to read as follows:
- 5. Informational center. Establish an informational center to be located on the capitol grounds to serve the public of Maine and visiting tourists, together with providing a service to our organizations, municipalities and industry. The center shall be operated during the hours when the regular state departments are open to the public and such other hours as deemed advisable. In addition to offering general information on locations of state departments and personnel, the informational center shall offer literature, maps, publications of state departments and pertinent data.
- Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Economic Development the sum of \$8,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968 and the sum of \$6,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
