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**AN ACT Increasing Salary of Commissioner of Labor and Industry.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. R. S., T. 26, § 41, amended.** The 5th sentence of section 41 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

The commissioner shall receive an annual salary of ~~\$9,000~~ **\$12,000**, and in addition \$1,000 annually for his services as a member of the Industrial Accident Commission and his actual, necessary cash expenses while away from his office on official business of the Industrial Accident Commission.

**Sec. 2. Appropriation.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Labor and Industry the sum of \$2,250 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968 and \$3,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969, for the purpose of carrying out this Act.
