RESOLVE, Utilizing Funds from Prison Industries Accounts for Certain Projects at the Maine State Prison.

Utilization of funds from prison industries accounts. Resolved: That the Warden of the Maine State Prison is authorized to utilize funds of the prison industries accounts for the following purposes:

1. Housing units. To relocate, renovate or rebuild 3 key personnel housing units located on property owned by the State, it being essential that such buildings be moved in order to permit the erection of the prison heating plant outside the prison walls.

2. Prison garage. To build an addition to the prison garage for storage of vehicles and to provide an area for rehabilitative vocational training in automotive mechanics; and be it further

Resolved: That in carrying out the projects authorized, prison labor and equipment and salvage materials shall be employed to the fullest extent practicable.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The utilization of funds from prison industries accounts for certain projects at the Maine State Prison would be for the purposes of renovating and rebuilding certain buildings and prison labor and equipment could be used to accomplish these purposes.
