SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 866, L. D. 1279, Bill, "An Act Appropriating Moneys for the Continuing Activites of the Committee on Aging."

Amend said Bill in the 19th line (15th and 16th lines in L.D. 1279) by striking out the figure and words "\$6,000, the above amount" and inserting in place thereof the following: '\$3,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968 and \$3,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969, the above amounts'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the emergency clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect July 1, 1967.'
