STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Qualifications of Insurance Brokers and Agents.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 24, § 2519, sub-§ 1, ¶ F, repealed and replaced. Paragraph F of subsection 1 of section 2519 of Title 24 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:
 - F. Has obtained or attempted to obtain such license, not for the purpose of holding himself or his company out to the general public as an insurance agent, but primarily for the purpose of soliciting, negotiating or procuring insurance contracts covering himself or members of his family, or the officers, directors, stockholders, partners, employees or debtors of a partnership, association or corporation of which he or a member of his family is an officer, director, stockholder, partner or employee.
