**RESOLVE, in Favor of Town of Greenbush, Penobscot County, for Damage
to Bridge.**

Town of Greenbush; compensated. Resolved: That there is appropriated the sum of \$470.57 from the General Highway Fund to the Town of Greenbush, Penobscot County, for damage to Spring Bridge by a state highway gravel truck.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In June 1966, a state highway gravel truck damaged Spring Bridge. The driver of the truck did not use caution in passing over the bridge as he did not cross on the crossing planks.
