**AN ACT Relating to Free Admission to School Athletic Events for Those
Eligible for Medicare.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 805, additional. Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 805, to read as follows:

§ 805. Athletic events; free admission for medicare card holders

Any resident of Maine, who is eligible for medicare, shall be admitted free of charge to any athletic event conducted by a public elementary or secondary school on exhibiting his medicare card.
