AN ACT Providing for a Professional Clearing House Plan for Public School Vacancies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 102, sub-§ 5-A, additional. Section 102 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection 5-A, to read as follows:

5-A. Listing of teaching and administrative vacancies. To maintain at all times in some easily observed manner or place a public listing of all teaching and administrative vacancies known to exist or about to exist in all public schools, both elementary and secondary. Vacancies in the positions of superintendents, in state colleges and universities shall be exempt from this subsection. The commissioner (of Education) is empowered to issue such directives to superintendents of schools, school boards and other executive personnel in the public school system as will bring about such public listing of vacancies, such listing to be kept current and up to date at all times.
