IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Dedication of Student Payments and Fees at the State Colleges.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 2307, additional. Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 2307, to read as follows:

§ 2307. Student payments and fees dedicated

All tuition and other students' payments and fees, including payments for board and room, except such payments as are reserved for the amortization of the principal and of the interest on self-amortizing dormitory and dining facilities bonds, at the state colleges shall be credited to the appropriate accounts at the respective state colleges and shall be available for expenditure upon allotment by the Governor and Council as provided in Title 5, section 1667.
