STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Permitting Northern Maine General Hospital of Eagle Lake to Maintain Nursing Home.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1907, c. 84, § 4, amended. Section 4 of chapter 84 of the private and special laws of 1907 is amended to read as follows:
- **Sec. 4. Quorum to transact business.** A majority in number of said corporators shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. Said corporation shall have the power to make such regulations and bylaws as may be necessary for the choice of all proper officers; to prescribe their duties and powers and to provide generally for the internal government and economy of the hospital corporation, such bylaws not being repugnant to the laws of the State.
- Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1907, c. 84, § 6-A, additional. Chapter 84 of the private and special laws of 1907, as amended, is further amended by adding a new section 6-A, to read as follows:
- Sec. 6-A. Nursing home. Said corporation is authorized to establish and maintain a nursing home to be known as the Northern Maine Security Home.
