STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Providing Complimentary Hunting and Fishing Licenses to Maine Residents Over Sixty-five Years of Age.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2601, sub-§ 11-A, amended. The first sentence of subsection 11-A of section 2601 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended to read as follows:

A complimentary license to **hunt and** fish shall be issued to any resident of Maine who is over 70 65 years of age and applies therefor to the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game.
