STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Compensation for Certain Municipal Officers Who Appear in District Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 4, § 173, sub-§ 4, amended. Subsection 4 of section 173 of Title 4 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

All municipal police officers, sheriffs, deputy sheriffs or constables who officially appear in and for the District Court at times other than their regular working hours shall be compensated out of the District Court Fund on an hourly basis equal to their present rate of employment as determined and ordered for payment by the District Court Judge.
