**AN ACT Relating to Signatures of Those Acknowledging Instruments to be
Recorded.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 33, § 203, amended. Section 203 of Title 33 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph, to read as follows:

Any notary public or justice of the peace before whom an acknowledgment is taken of a deed or other written instrument under this section shall type his name on the instrument directly under his written signature.
