AN ACT Defining Certain Vessels as an Industrial Project under the Industrial Building Authority.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 10, § 703, sub-§ 3, ¶ C, additional. Subsection 3 of section 703 of Title 10 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 2 of chapter 471 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended by adding a new paragraph C, to read as follows:

C. Any fishing vessel documented or to be documented as a fishing vessel of the United States, which is designed to be used for catching, processing or transporting fish or any vessel outfitted for such activity.
