AN ACT Increasing Salary of Director of Legislative Research.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 3, § 163, sub-§ 7, amended. The last sentence of subsection 7 of section 163 of Title 3 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 4 of chapter 412 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended to read as follows:

He shall receive a salary of ~~\$13,000~~ **\$16,000** per year and any necessary traveling expenses:

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Legislative Research Committee the sum of \$2,475 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968 and the sum of \$3,300 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969 to carry out the purposes of this Act.
